2023 DONATIONS

2023 is a year of firsts for the Artists Guild. It was the first year attendance at the Annual Art Show peaked to over 600 attendees. It was the first year student art from Freedom Elementary and Haile Middle, the schools we sponsor, was displayed. It was the first year we expanded our reach to underserved children by donating to the Summer Camp Scholarship Program at ArtCenter Manatee. And it was the first year our fundraising efforts reached a level to allow us to donate \$10,200! Yes, \$10,200.

Both schools received \$2,500 for their visual arts programs, for a total of \$5,000. These funds help the art instructors buy supplies to sustain their programs. \$2500 was donated to the Manatee Summer Camp ArtCenter Scholarship Program for underserved children in our county. An additional \$700 was donated to Freedom allowing them to purchase portable display panels. Plus an additional \$2000 went to Haile to sponsor a field trip for their art students to Duncan McClellan Gallery, where they will learn about glass art and have a hands experience in the art of glass etching.
